Racism Strikes Again

The picture on television and in the newspaper was unmistakable- the right hand and arm raised high and straight. Only the words "Sieg Heil" were missing but the message of the neo- Nazi movement that gathered in Charlottesville this past week was clear. We could single out James Fields, a neo Nazi sympathizer, as a madman who drove his car into a crowd of counter protesters and killed one woman and injured 19. But the threat to our society and its values goes far beyond the action of one individual. The growing numbers in the white supremacist movements and alt-right organizations suggests that we are entering a new era of racism and bigotry.

From an historical perspective you could say that we have made great strides in our country in the last 50 years to remove vestiges of racism and bigotry, yet such mindsets are hard to root out. The temptation to see "the other" as less than equal and a threat to my security and well-being is always there. It is part of our fallen nature or in traditional terms one of the effects of original sin. As Christians we are called upon to resist that temptation and to be forthright in countering words or actions that reveal bias and prejudice.

The strong reaction across the political spectrum in condemning the action of extremists this week is a hopeful sign that as citizens we hold dear the fundamental truth that all persons are created equal and as believers we recognize every life as precious in the sight of God.

Sadness at Sachem

Sachem School District is one of the largest on Long Island, but that did not diminish the personal outpouring of sympathy and compassion extended to the family of Joshua Mileto. They lost their son in an accident during a football pre-season exercise at Sachem East High School where Joshua was a student. Of course there will be an on-going investigation into the cause and circumstances of the tragedy, but that will not undo the heartache and sorrow that is felt by Joshua's family, his teammates, and the school community.

A funeral Mass for this young man was held last Tuesday at our neighboring parish of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Ronkonkoma. Bishop Barres was present for the liturgy. Our Catholic rituals speak so powerfully in times of crisis and tragedy and shed light in times of darkness, especially the darkness of death.

Good News!

August 27, 2017 Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time (A) Is 22:19-23 Rom 11:33-36 Mt 16:13-20

Saint Peter's Basilica is built on the tomb of Peter, which literally serves as the rock on which the church is built. Peter states his faith, acknowledging Jesus as Messiah and Son of God, in the name of the other apostles. In reply, the Lord reveals his intended mission for Peter: to become the visible foundation of the Church.

This account also tells us that Peter's act of faith did not come through "flesh and blood," that is, through his human abilities, but through a particular revelation from God. By contrast, right afterward, as Jesus foretells his passion, death, and resurrection, Peter "began to rebuke him," denying that this would ever happen (Matthew 16:22). Jesus scolds him in return.

Peter shows his human weakness and what he is: a stone along the path on which men can stumble. In this scene, the drama of each soul and the history of the papacy and Church itself are anticipated. There is the joint presence of divine assistance by which the papacy constitutes the Church's foundation throughout history, and human weakness, which is also evident through the centuries and can be transformed only through abandonment to God's action.

In today's Gospel, Jesus clearly promises the forces of evil will not prevail. Prophets such as Jeremiah (1:18–19) were threatened only by human enemies, whereas Peter will have to be defended from a supernatural evil. Jeremiah receives a promise that affects him as a person and his prophetic ministry; Peter receives assurances concerning the future of the Church and the new community founded by Christ "upon this rock."
