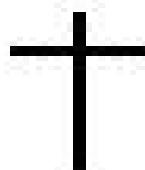

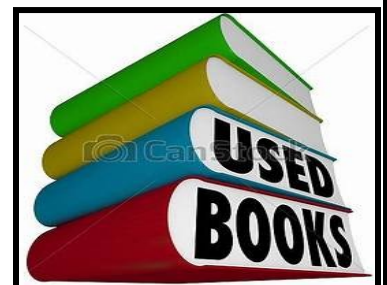

Godparents and Sponsors

What a wonderful feeling it is to be asked to be a **Godparent** or **Sponsor**. We feel honored and grateful. But what are we being asked to do? Are there special things that we need to do, to bring? How do we prepare for these honored positions?

First off, these titles call us to a special, lifelong commitment. A commitment to share a special relationship of our faith with another person to serve as a resource, a guide, and an example of what the Catholic faith is about.

Both of these titles have the same requirements: mature enough to understand their responsibilities (generally considered to be 16 years of age); have received the three sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist; be a practicing member of the Catholic Church.

What are we being asked to do?

Godparents – when a parent asks you to be a Godparent for their child, they are asking you to be an example for their child; to help them teach their child what it means to be a faithful Catholic; having a prayerful relationship with God. To have a lifelong relationship with this child which will inspire them to be faithful Catholics. What an honor to be a Godparent!

Sponsors – when a candidate for Confirmation asks you to be their Sponsor, they are asking you to stand behind them at their Confirmation and by your commitment, profess with them that they are a true believer in Catholic doctrine. They are placing great trust that you care about their spiritual growth as they profess their wish to take responsibility for their faith. What an honor to be a Sponsor!

Are there special things we need to do, to bring?

If you are asked to be a Godparent, go to your parish rectory office and ask for a document stating that you are a parishioner, and have received all of the sacraments of initiation, and give this document to the parents. Check with the parents if there is anything special you may need for this momentous occasion and remember to add this child to your prayers.

If you are asked to be a Sponsor for a confirmation candidate, go to your parish rectory office and ask for a document stating that you are a parishioner, and have received all of the sacraments of initiation, and give this document to the candidate so that they may submit it to their parish religious office with their other documents in preparation for their confirmation and add this person to your prayers.

How do we prepare for these special positions?

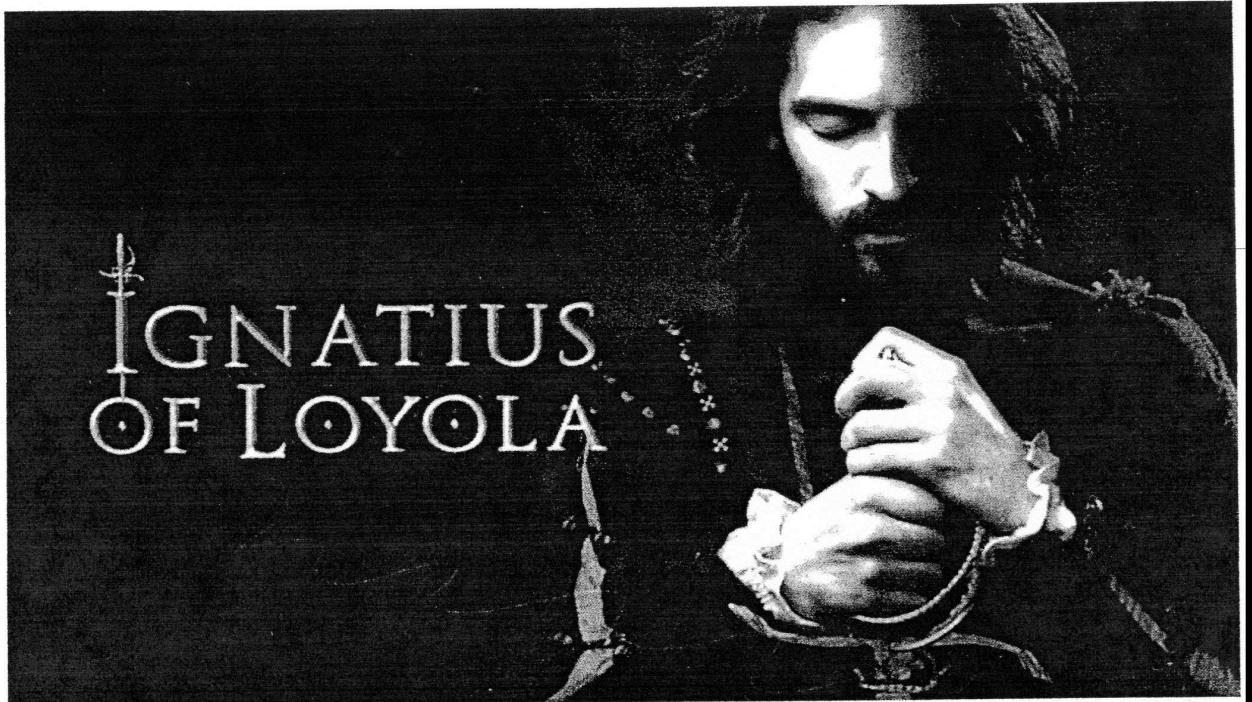
St. Ignatius Loyola Parish has Baptismal preparation classes on the third Sunday of most months at 2:00PM. (Check with the Rectory Office for schedule). First time parents are required to attend these classes and we invite any godparents to join them. If you have been asked to be a Godparent, you are welcome to attend these classes, even if this is not the first child, all are welcome.

On the **BIG DAY** for both Baptism and Confirmation, plan on being early and listen for any announcements for Godparents or Sponsors.

Stay active in your faith and always be ready to help your Godchild and that special person who asked you to be their sponsor with any issue relating to their faith. Remember, you can always refer them to a priest or deacon if you are not sure of the answer.

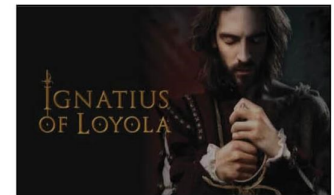

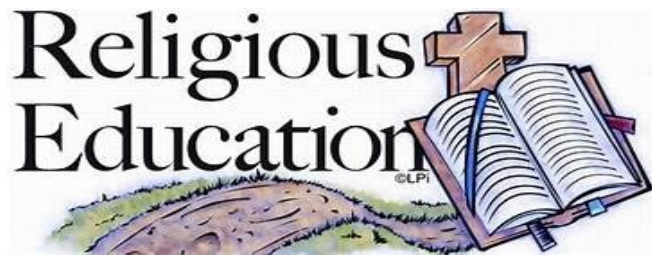

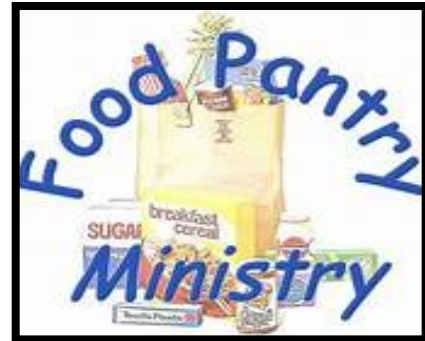


The Religious Education Office will be closed for the months of July and August. Registration forms will be available at the Rectory or on the parish website. Registration forms must be returned by June 30th. After June 30th, there will be a \$25 late fee charged.

All children who are attending the 1st grade through the 8th grade in the local public schools must be registered in the Religious Education Program.

In order to receive the Sacraments of Penance and First Holy Communion children must have 2 years of studies. Religion classes continue for the 3, 4, 5, 6, 7th grades. Students will be eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation after 7 years of Religious Education studies.

Thank you for your interest in the Senior Observer Program at Nassau Community College. As you are aware, the Senior Observer Program enables residents of Nassau County who are 60 years or older to observe college courses on a tuition-free basis. Senior observers do not receive credit or grades for the courses they observe and need not take exams.

The Senior Observer Program is a part of the College's Lifelong Learning Department. Please note the following program guidelines as set by the Academic Senate:

1. All senior observers must be properly registered for a course through the Senior Observer Program Office. Please be sure that you meet all prerequisites for a desired course or obtain permission from the department chair prior to registration.
2. A senior observer must be officially registered in a course and submit an official registration permit to the instructor to be admitted to the class. **Senior observers that are not officially registered for a course will be refused admittance.**
3. Enrollment is on a space available basis and is limited to two senior observers per course section.
4. Senior observers may not observe a particular course more than two times.
5. Senior observers may be displaced from their assigned class if the class size exceeds the class limit or at the instructor's discretion.
6. Senior observers should adhere to the same attendance policy as officially enrolled NCC students.
7. Certain courses (as determined by Department Chairs) are not available to senior observers. The Senior Observer Brochure is as accurate as possible. It includes all courses/sections for which senior observers are eligible to observe.

To be eligible for registration in the Senior Observer Program, participants must submit proof of age and residency (driver's license, Nassau County Senior Citizen Pass or other official documentation) with a completed registration form to Lifelong Learning prior to the registration deadline. Registrations can be submitted by mail, fax or online at www.ncc.edu/seniorobserver.

If you need advice on how to schedule your classes, the volunteers in the Senior Observer Volunteer Office will be able to assist you. Their office is located in the Tower Building, 2nd Floor. Please call 516.572.7200 for hours.

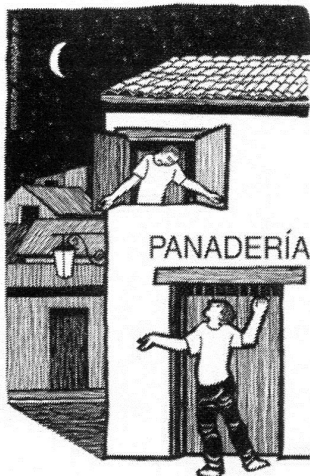
